**WCC Projects Update**

- **Weston Community Garden:** Still no communication from the board of the Weston Recreation Center; Marisa will follow up again.

- **Civilian Conservation Corps Trail:** Trail workday scheduled Tuesday, October 12, at 9 am. Anne, Andrew and Deborah will participate. The kiosk is built and ready to go. The photos and maps are complete. Weston Historical Society is to provide the text.

- **“Bee the Change”:** Deborah will stay on top of this and follow up as needed. This would involve designating an acre of municipal land—currently mowed or unused—for a dynamic pollinator meadow. Bee the Change ([www.beethechangehoney.com](http://www.beethechangehoney.com)) would provide seeds, expertise and manpower. Twenty-five Vermont towns are participating so far.

**Old and New Business**

- **Londonderry Conservation Commission:** Deborah has been in touch with the Chair of the Londonderry Conservation Commission who is interested in working on a collaborative educational program with us. We will be thinking about program ideas and discuss at our next meeting.

- **New projects ideas:** With major projects winding down, it was agreed we need to begin thinking about new areas of interest. Preliminary ideas included creating a Conservation section with suggested reading and educational materials for the Wilder Memorial Library web site, and clearing and maintaining a recreational trail from Moses Pond Road to Turner Road.
