

Town of Weston  
Class 4 Highway Policy

General:

Anyone wishing to perform or arrange for maintenance on a class 4 highway or trail on public land must make a written request describing the scope of the work to the Selectboard and the Road Foreman and receive written approval from the Selectboard prior to commencing work. In general, the cost of the work will be borne by the person or entity making the request and that person or entity will indemnify the Town. When the work is completed, the Town will be notified in writing so that it can arrange for inspection and approval of the work.

Summer Maintenance:

As time permits, the Road Foreman will inspect class 4 highways and do maintenance as he or she deems appropriate. Improvements or upgrades may be undertaken with the permission of the Selectboard.

Winter Maintenance:

The Town is not obligated to provide any winter maintenance on Class IV Roads. Plowing or other winter maintenance by private parties must be approved by the Selectboard.

Changes of Classification:

It is the policy of the Selectboard to discourage the reclassification and/or the upgrading of trails and Class IV Roads. However, it is the right of landowners or voters totaling at least 5% of the voters to request changes in road status. The Selectboard will consult the relevant Vermont Statutes including Title 19, Sections 708-717 when considering such requests.


