CERTIFIED STATEMENT DESIGNATING A

NO-PARKING ZONE ON THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM

In accordance with Title 23 Vermont Statutes Annotated, Section 1101, the following no-parking zone is hereby designated for the section of state highway described:

Route No. 100 Town Weston

Exact location: Following are the No Parking zones established on Route 100 in the Village of Weston:

(1) on the west side of Route 100 from a point 175 feet north of Town Highway #40 running northerly a distance of 175 feet.

(2) on the west side of Route 100 from State Aid Highway #2 to a point 0.07 mile south of State Aid Highway #1.

(3) on the east side of Route 100 from a point 475 feet south of State Aid Highway #2 running northerly for a distance of 315 Feet.

(4) ~~XXXX~~ On the east side of Route 100 from state Aid Highway #2 to State Aid Highway #1. (Supersedes No Parking zone established October 10, 1972).
The official signs designating the foregoing no-parking zone were placed

by the Department of Highways on August 2, 1977.
