Dear Ken,

As Co-Chairs of the Weston Conservation Commission, we are responding to your June 6<sup>th</sup> letter regarding technical violations of the Open Meeting Law. Thank you for raising the issues so the WCC can take a closer look at them.

We will be reviewing the past meeting minutes to determine what actions, if any, were taken that need to be ratified. It is our recollection that no actions were taken at these meetings that would need to be ratified, but of course we will check the minutes again to confirm. If you can identify any specific actions that you believe need to be ratified that would be appreciated.

As to completing a training session and adopting internal procedures regarding the requirements of the Open Meeting Law, it would be very helpful if you had a specific suggestion in this regard beyond providing the Conservation Commission members with the Open Meeting Law (1 VSA 310-314) and the Conservation Commission Statute (24 VSA 4501-4505) which you did at our last meeting on June 2. Going forward, the WCC will ensure that it publishes its agendas and provides information as to how to access meetings held remotely as necessary to comply with applicable statutes.
