CERTIFIED STATEMENT DESIGNATING A

SPECIAL REGULATION AS TO PARKING ON THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM

In accordance with Title 23 Vermont Statutes Annotated Section 1008, the following special regulation as to parking is hereby designated for the section of state highway described.

Route No. 100 Town Weston

Exact location and regulation: Following are the No-Parking Zones established on Route 100 in the Village of Weston:

(1) On the west side of Route 100 from a point 175 feet north of Town Highway No. 40 running northerly for a distance of 175 feet.

(2) On the west side of Route 100 from State Aid Highway No. 2 to a point 0.13 mile south of State Aid Highway No. 1.

(3) on the east side of Route 100 from a point 475 feet south of State Aid Highway No. 2 running northerly for a distance of 315 feet.

(4) On the east side of Route 100 from State Aid Highway No. 2 to State Aid Highway No. 1.

The official signs designating the foregoing special regulation as to parking were posted by the Department of Highways on November 2, 1972.
